Club Veterans Voucher Program.

The NSWVGA is in the process of providing vouchers to each club to assist with the running of a daily trophy to be determined by that club. It is not an addition to open days but to an event conducted by each veterans club as part of their yearly program.

2020 Week of Golf Program

The 2020 program has been ratified by the board and will be posted on the website this month. The 2021 program is in the draft stage and will shortly be sent to all Tournament Directors for comment.

Group 14 has the most weeks of golf with six weeks of golf being scheduled throughout the year . This year Grafton will conduct a trial week . Jeff Hackett and is committee have things well in hand with flyers being sent to all clubs and a nomination form accessible on the NSWVGA website. I urge all group 14 clubs support Grafton to make their week of golf a success.

Eligibility at Open Days

Just a reminder that all NSWVGA financial members are eligible to participate in any Open Day in NSW either Male or Female.
