ELECTION of OFFICE BEARERS 2023 ... Michael Cook (Ocean Shores) did not seek re-election **John Lowe** (Lismore) was re-elected PRESIDENT ... unopposed

Ray Kent (Murwillumbah) was re-elected unopposed

Grant Evans (Coolangatta Tweed Heads) was elected (ONLY NOM<INATION received) as Vice-President North

Rod Ellis (Maclean) was elected as Vice-President South after a Ballot was contested for the remaining position (which Wayne Rogers oversaw)

Peter Hamilton (Maclean) was re-appointed as NRVGA Auditor for 2023

Wayne moved Positions be confirmed and that Ballot Papers be destroyed ... CARRIED

 John Lowe as President congratulated and welcomed the new Committee. Ray stated that the Committee would meet prior to the 2023 Golfing Program Season via Zoom. An Agenda would be sent

GENERAL BUSINESS ...

- NRVGA Veteran Open Days ... (Conducted by John and Ray
 - o These Days are NRVGA Days run by each Affiliated Club on behalf of NRVGA
 - They are opportunities for each Club to present their Course
 - The Programmed Days are to promote Camaraderie and provide enjoyment for Veteran Golfers
 - We need to ensure that these days are conducted using the same format
 - Stableford Medley no separate Ladies Competition
 - There are No Grades
 - The Competition is to be a Shotgun Start
 - All players must be affiliated with NSWVGA
 - If numbers permit, TWO FIELDS are played AM and PM
 - If Visiting Veterans who are Members of NSWVGA nominate, they are accepted and can play - but they cannot win the Non-Local-Non-Win NRVGA Prize (\$25.00)

Each Club Delegate spoke about the Charge being costed by their Club for Veteran Visitors on the Programmed Veteran Open Day.

These Costs ranged from \$9.00 to \$26.00 with the higher costs relating the larger 18 Hole Clubs. The costs imposed by their Boards are considered upkeeping costs imposed on Visitors. Some of the larger Clubs do offer a slightly lower cost after negotiation with their Veteran Club

These higher costs makes it extremely difficult for the larger Clubs to provide the Day at a cost of \$35.00 as these Clubs have contracted Caterers who must pass on costs Some Clubs seek sponsorship for these Veteran Days so that costs can be covered and a s mall profit made

After much discussion, a Motion was put by Peter Taylor and Seconded by Jeoff Turner, "that Clubs can charge the Nomination Fee to a maximum of \$35.00. On the Nomination Form it must be stated if this includes Lunch or No Lunch. If there is to be No Lunch, it is to state if Food can be available for purchase" ... Motion CARRIED by Majority Against x 2 (Byron Bay and Ballina)

Before moving on in General Business, it was decided to adopt the format for Nomination Forms ...

- o Nomination Forms are to be sent in an 'excel' Format for ease of returning
- o Issued to Clubs 6 Weeks prior to Date of Play
- Closing Date 2 Weeks prior to Date of Play
- Draw completed and published 1 Week prior to Date of Play
- Send Draw to Secretaries and Ray for publishing on Website
